Welcome to the January edition of the Coopers Gap Wind Farm Newsletter!

The Coopers Gap Wind Farm is helping reduce Australia's carbon footprint by generating enough clean energy to power up to 232,000 Queensland homes annually.

Since January 2025, the wind farm has generated over 1,290GWh of clean energy, the equivalent to removing over 390,000 cars off the road and offsetting over 900,000 tonnes of CO₂.

What's happening on site?

On site at Coopers Gap Wind Farm, regular monitoring continues to ensure turbines are operating efficiently.

Acoustic monitoring was completed earlier in 2025 in accordance with the Noise Compliance Test Plan. In August 2025, we received the Noise Monitoring Report, demonstrating that the Wind Farm is compliant with all relevant noise criteria. Benefit Sharing

This year, the Coopers Gap Wind Farm Community Enhancement Fund was fully allocated, supporting a variety of fantastic local projects.

In total, \$122,719 was invested in community initiatives across Bell, Bunya Mountains, Jandowae, Kumbia and Cooranga North. Ten projects were funded via the Community Enhancement Fund and an additional two projects were funded directly with top up funding ([see table on page two for full list](#)).
