The Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) understands that you wish to undertake the above proposal which has been referred to the Authority for consideration of its potential environmental impact.

This proposal raises a number of environmental issues. However, the EPA has decided not to subject this proposal to the environmental impact assessment process and the subsequent setting of formal conditions by the Minister for Environment under Part IV of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). Nevertheless, the staff of the Office of the EPA will provide advice to you and relevant authorities on the environmental aspects of the proposal. That advice will be forwarded following completion of the appeals process and made available to the public.

The EPA's decision to not assess the proposal is open to appeal. There is a 14-day period, closing 26 September 2011, during which, on payment of the \$10 appeal fee, an appellant may ask the Minister to consider directing the EPA to reconsider this decision or conduct a formal assessment.
