CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Palmer Wind Farm is now under construction and expected to be completed in mid 2028.

The Palmer Wind Farm will help secure Australia's energy future by generating up to 288MW of clean energy when constructed. That's enough to power up to 142,000 South Australian homes.

What's happening on site?

The project team is:

- completing clearance of unexploded ordnances from the old Palmer-Tungkillo Field Firing Range,
- building two permanent site access points on Randell Road,
- constructing the site compound which includes construction offices and amenities,
- installing boundary and landholder fencing, and
- commencing construction of the internal road network to link up the turbines and substations.

As construction activities increase, there will be more traffic in the area and some traffic changes on Randell Road. We appreciate your patience.
