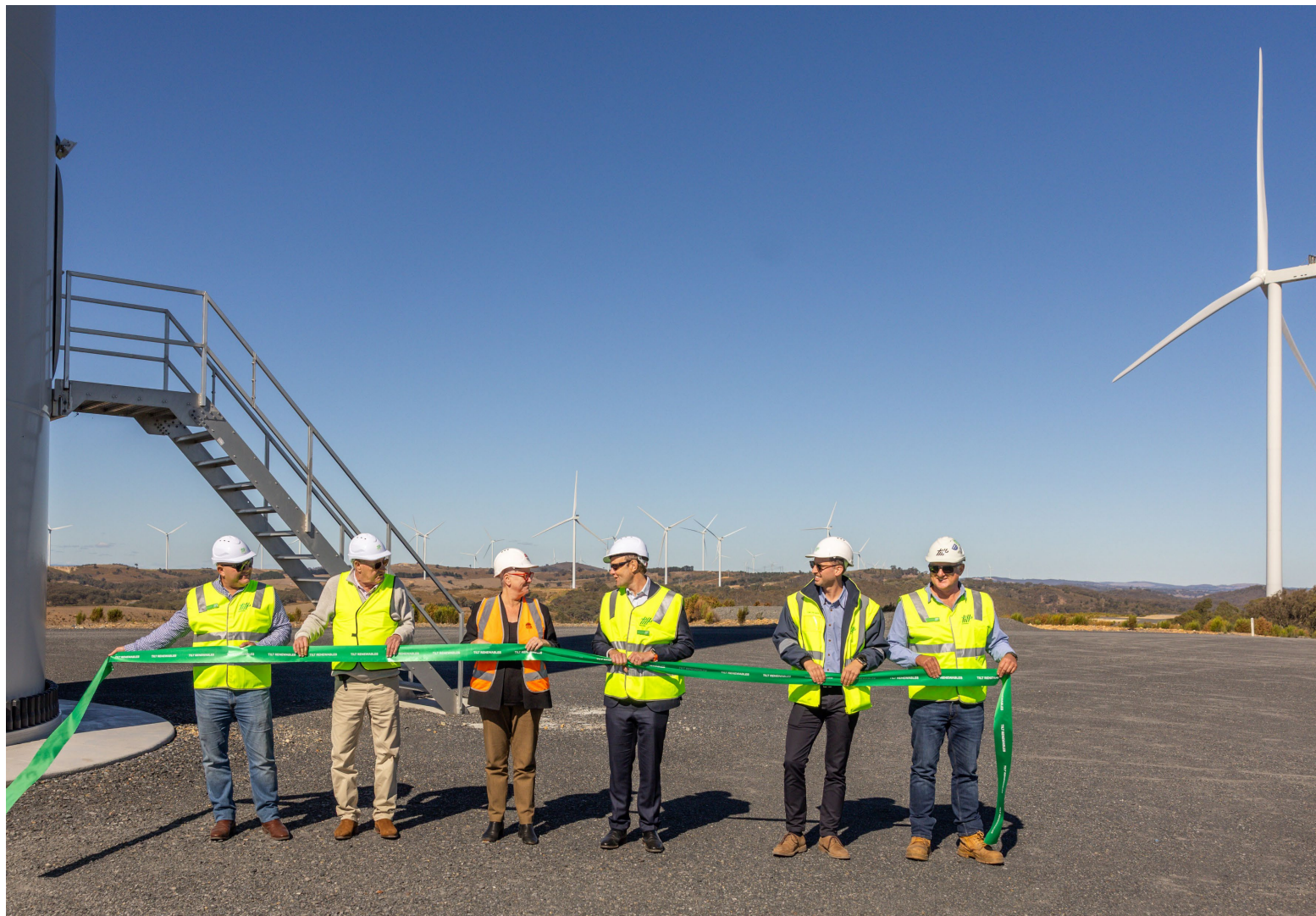

- Maintenance of met masts completed



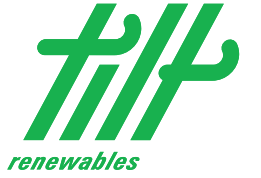
# ACOUSTIC COMPLIANCE

# ENVIRONMENT & COMPLIANCE



## Biodiversity Management

- On-site rehabilitation activities are completed (ongoing monitoring until success criteria is met).
- Bird and bat monitoring ongoing at 33 of the 66 turbines and will continue as per the BBAMP schedule. First yearly report is expected late 2025.

## Modification Application

- Tilt is moving modification internally, decision has been made to progress
- Notice of intent to modify to be submitted later in year
- Targeted engagement with councils and key stakeholders has commenced and will continue throughout the modification process
- Further information and more detailed briefing will be shared at the next CCC meeting
