CCC ACTIONS

- DJ to contact DPHI re need for aviation lights on turbines, and to follow up with the three Councils to determine their support in having the aviation lights removed from the turbines.
- Tilt (BW) to provide information to AF to enable access to noise monitoring details and data.
- Tilt to provide contact details in next Newsletter for those having reception problems with TV, internet or communications.
- Tilt to include note in next newsletter providing contact details and offering final visual mitigation planting to those eligible

Rye Park Wind Farm officially enters full operations

- All 66 turbines are now operating
- Project commissioning is complete
- Power is being used by:
 - Cadia Gold Mine, a significant regional employer
 - AGL, NSWs oldest energy retailer

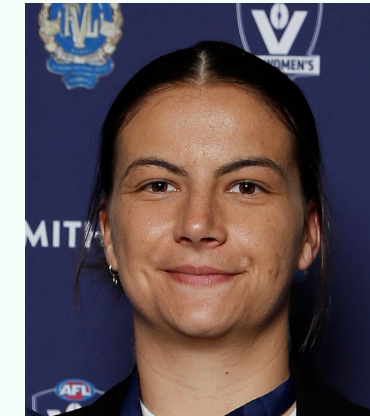


Operations team

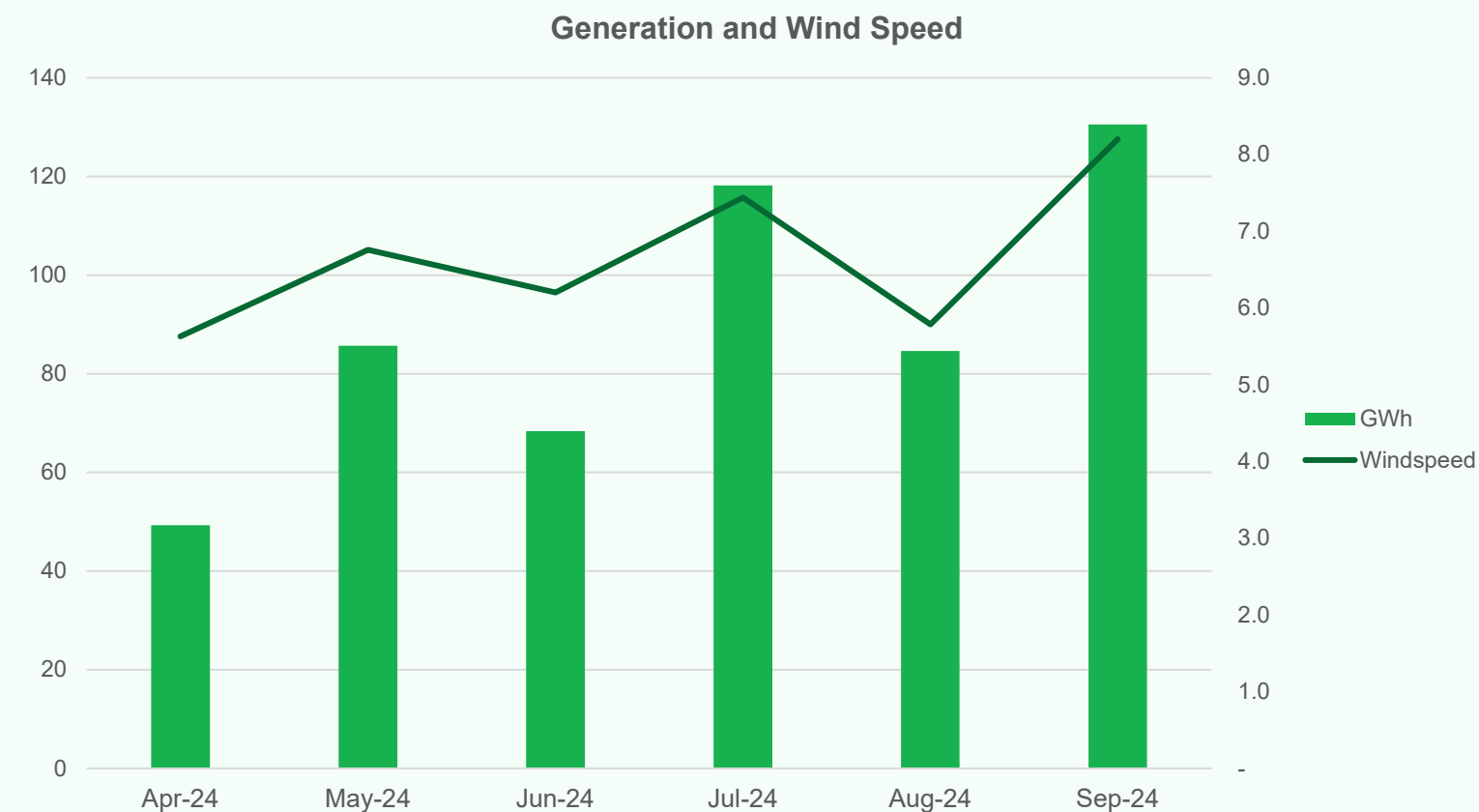

PROJECT UPDATE

How we are doing so far

- 537 GWh generated over the last 6 months.
- 96% capacity factor achieved on 2 September 2024 with 8.9GWh generated.
- Best performing Eventus wind farm in the world, with Lost Production Factor 0.97% against site target of below 2%.
- 3 monthly service on track to be completed end of October. Annual service ongoing.

COMPLIANCE

Complaints and Compliance

- Noise monitoring is scheduled to happen later this year. This will ensure the project is below the required limits.
- 3 x television reception complaints closed out since the last CCC.
- No Non-compliance reported since the last CCC.

Biodiversity Management

- On-site rehabilitation activities are completed (ongoing monitoring until success criteria is met).
- All biodiversity offset credits have been retired by the project.
- Bird and bat monitoring ongoing at 33 of the 66 turbines and will continue as per the BBAMP schedule. First yearly report is expected late 2024.

Initial Operational Requirements

- Notification given to Planning Secretary on commencement of full operations.
- Key requirements to be completed within 3 months of commencement of full operations:
 - Minor review of Bird and Bat Adaptive Management Plan (BBAMP) submitted to department – findings from implementation of plan and impacts identified through the commissioning phase.
 - Independent audit of compliance with conditions of the Development Consent and relevant Operational management plans underway.

Modification Application

- Tilt are progressing modification and are in discussions with DPHI prior to lodgment.
