

Waddi Wind Farm

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Waddi Wind Farm will deliver 108 MW of renewable energy, enough to power 68,000 homes. Construction of the project is now underway, bringing employment and broader benefits to the region.

Since mobilising on-site in February, our team has made significant progress in preparing the site for major works later this year.

Our construction workforce is now working on a rotating roster between 7am and 7pm, Monday to Sunday.

There are approximately 50-75 workers and 30-40 vehicles on-site daily.

Construction highlights

Work is progressing well on the turbine foundations, with blinding now installed in 5 of 18 foundations.

Blinding (pictured in Figure 1) is a thin layer of concrete that creates a clean, level and dry base for steel reinforcement.

With the blinding installed, steelworks for the anchor cages has started in 3 of the 18 foundations (pictured in Figure 2).

Upcoming impacts

No significant impacts are expected in the next fortnight.
