

Waddi Wind Farm

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Waddi Wind Farm will deliver 108 MW of renewable energy, enough to power 68,000 homes. Construction of the project is now underway, bringing employment and broader benefits to the region.

Since our last update, we have achieved a major construction milestone for Waddi Wind Farm.

We are pleased to share that concrete has been poured in the first four turbine foundations (pictured in Figures 1 and 2).

This milestone highlights the significant progress that has been made on-site since mobilising in February.

Construction highlights

- 16 of 18 turbine foundations have now been excavated
- 11 of 18 anchor cages have been installed in turbine foundations
- 7 of 18 turbines foundations are ready for concrete to be poured

Upcoming impacts

Locals may notice increased lighting at night during concrete pours.

These generally take place on Wednesday and Friday nights, and lighting should not impact local residences. Please contact our team if you have any concerns.
