The project has a potential capacity of up to 1,100 MW, capable of strengthening energy security for up to 650,000 Western Australian homes.

The project team has undertaken investigations to confirm the site's suitability for a wind farm.

The project remains subject to further development studies, assessment and approval before it can be constructed.

Project update

Since acquiring the project in February 2026, our team has been busy working with landholders, community organisations and technical stakeholders to develop the project.

We recently reached an important development milestone by making an application to the Shire of Moora for the installation of four meteorological masts (Figures 1 to 3) to measure wind conditions.

We expect to share more information about the installation of the meteorological masts later this year, subject to approval of the application.

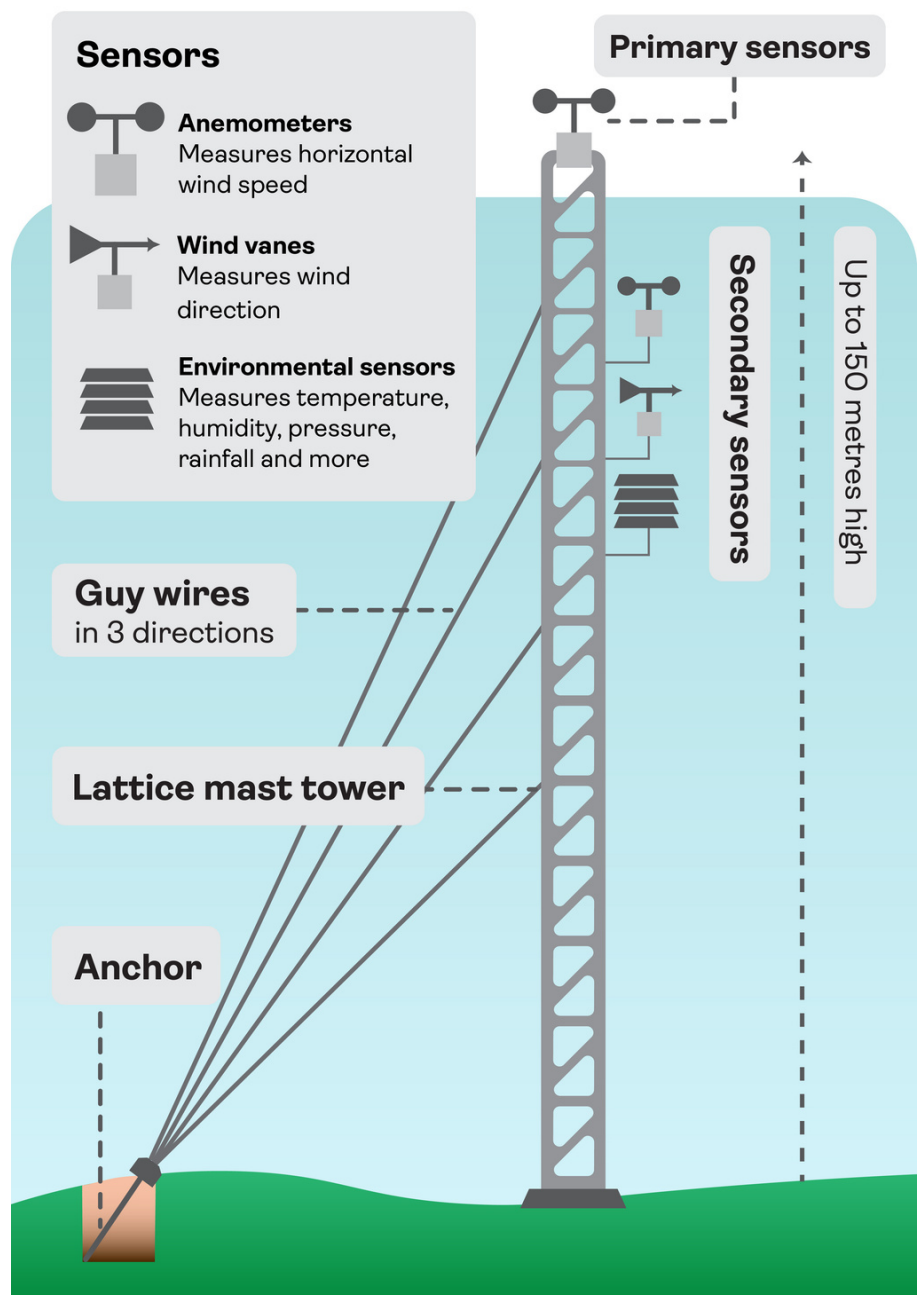


Figure 3: Meteorological mast diagram. Artist's impression only, not to scale.

The project is in an area with high wind speeds, approximately 140km north of Perth on the lands of the Yued people near Moora.

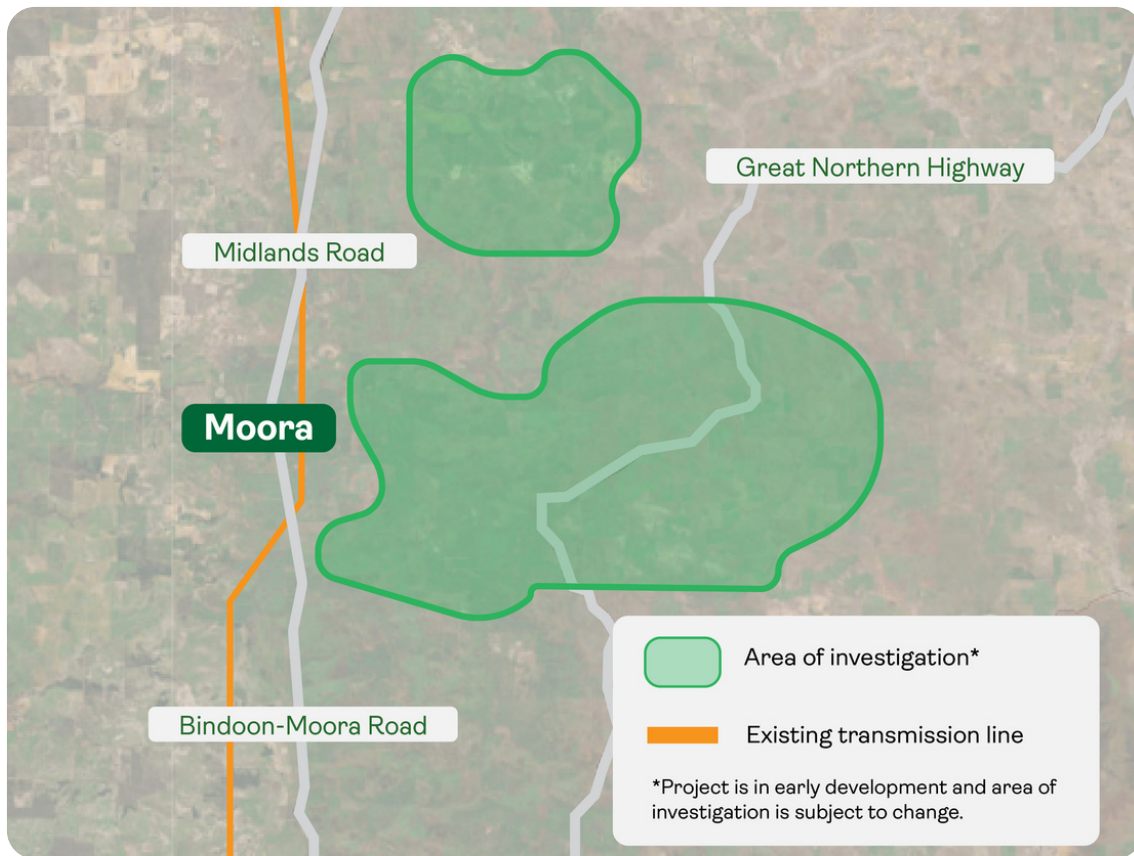
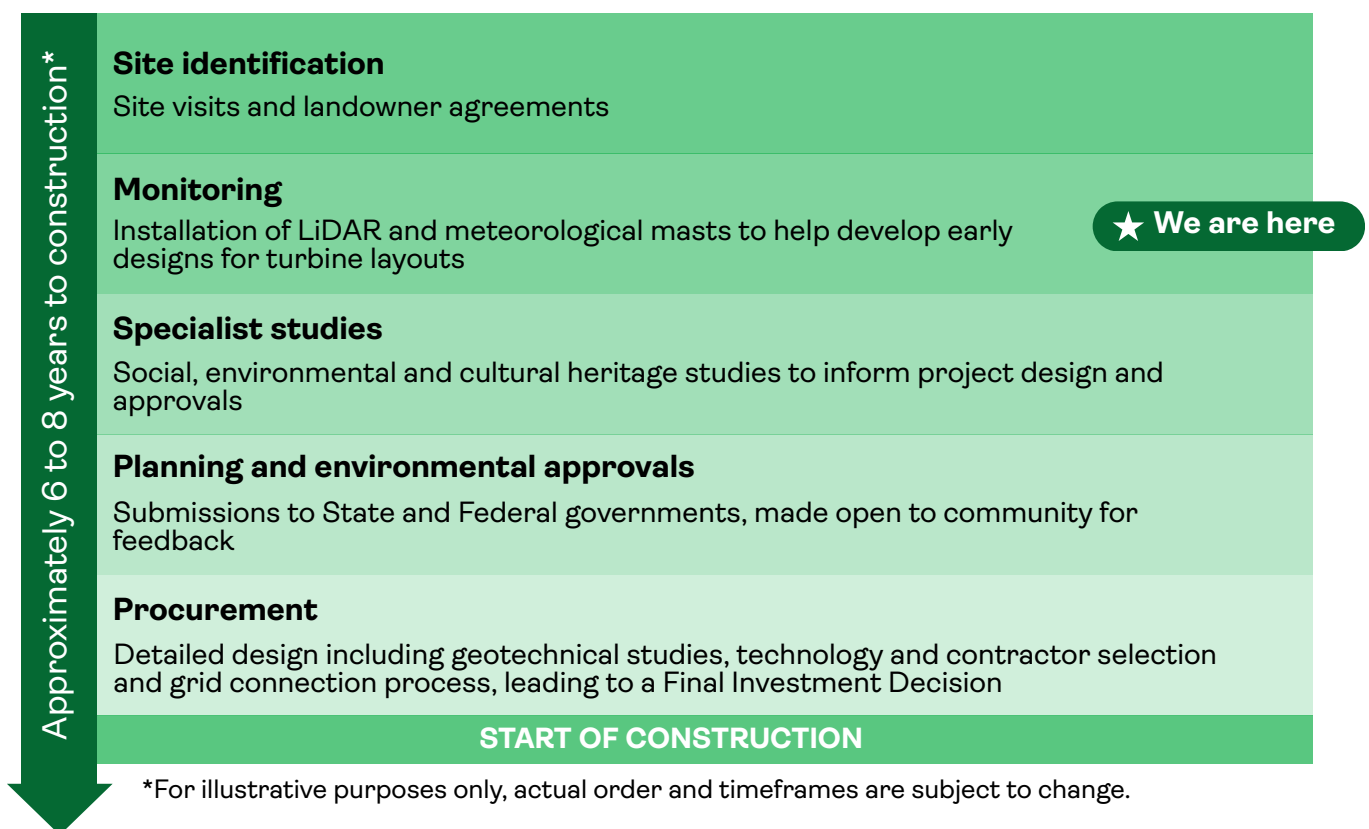


Figure 4: Map of Central Midlands Wind Farm area of investigation
