



Dundonnell Wind Farm Education Fund Guidelines for individuals

What is the Dundonnell Wind Farm Education Fund?

The Dundonnell Wind Farm Education Fund provides financial support to help local teenagers, adults or not for profit organisations access education, training and learning opportunities that may otherwise be difficult to afford or access.

Funding may help with things such as:

- School or further education
- TAFE or tertiary study
- Registered training courses
- Short courses or certificates
- Tutoring
- Educational resources or equipment
- Other education or training costs

Am I eligible to apply?

You may be eligible if:

- You live in or around the Dundonnell Wind Farm area, *including Dundonnell, Darlington, Derrinallum, Lake Bolac, Nerrin Nerrin, Pura Pura, Streatham, Vite Vite or Woorndoo.*
- You are a teenager or adult undertaking education or training.
- You need financial assistance to access education, training or learning.
- You are a charitable or not-for-profit organisation supporting an educational need.
- You are a community group supporting an educational need.
- You are applying, but have not yet been accepted
- Your application needs to demonstrate a genuine education or training need and explain how the funding will provide an educational benefit.

What should I include on my application?

Before you apply, think about the following questions:

1. What would you like funding for?
Tell us what you need and how much it will cost. Please provide a quote or cost details **if available**.
2. Why do you need this funding?
Tell us why financial assistance is important and how it will help you.
3. How will this funding make a difference?
Tell us how it will support your education, training, career, personal development or benefit your community. Include when you will need the funding.

You don't need to have all the answers before starting. If you're unsure whether your idea is eligible, please contact the DDWF Community Fund Committee or a member of the Tilt Renewables team before completing your application.



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What happens if my application is successful?

Successful applicants will need to supply proof of enrolment before funds are distributed and when their course, project or initiative is finished, complete a Report Back Form.

The Report Back form is simply an opportunity to tell the Committee:

- What you did and what you achieved
- How the funding was used and what difference it has made
- Keep your receipts and records of how the funding is spent.

The Report Back form can be found on the applicable section on the Dundonnell Wind Farm project webpage.

If funding is not used for the approved purpose, unused funds may need to be returned to the Community Fund Committee.
