

Waddi Wind Farm

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Waddi Wind Farm will deliver 108 MW of renewable energy, enough to power 68,000 homes. Construction of the project is now underway, bringing employment and broader benefits to the region.

Works are progressing well at Waddi Wind Farm as we continue to reach construction milestones for the project:

- ✓ All 18 turbine foundations have now been excavated
- ✓ Blinding (thin layer of concrete that creates a level base) has been installed in all 18 turbine foundations

Other construction highlights

- 11 of 18 anchor cages have been installed in turbine foundations
- 7 of 18 turbine foundations have had concrete poured

Upcoming impacts

Works on Mullering Road are expected to start in October 2026, please subscribe for SMS updates using the QR code below.

Locals may notice increased lighting at night during concrete pours.
